Put your desire to get involved to good use, become a **State Emergency Service (SES) volunteer**. The SES offers an opportunity to participate in and develop a variety of emergency and rescue skills and is designed to empower people to help themselves and others in their communities in times of emergency and disaster.

PREREQUISITES

- Enthusiastic, adventurous, and willing to give back to your community
- Willing and able to activate during disasters and emergencies
- Be able to commit approximately 15-25hrs per month towards training and service
- Applicants may be required to possess a certain level of fitness appropriate to the role and the functions they will be performing

New volunteers will be invited to attend induction training by their local SES group. Training and education is ongoing for SES volunteers, and over time you can expect to develop your skills in most of the following areas:

- First aid
- Map reading and navigation
- How to operate a two-way radio
- Basic rescue
- Rescue from heights and depths
- Road crash rescue
- Flood boat rescue
- Emergency operations management
- Storm damage response
- Land search techniques
