Our Vacation Program offers:

Santos offers 12 weeks' vacation employment to students who are currently in their penultimate year of undergraduate study.

Offered November through February each year, the program provides students with hands on experience through challenging project work. It gives students the chance to determine their interest in the industry, and Santos an opportunity to assess student potential for the following year's graduate positions.

As a Vacation Student, you'll get the opportunity to improve your knowledge and skills and enhance your personal development through hands-on experience, defined and challenging project work and working alongside subject matter experts. At the conclusion of the program, you will deliver a presentation on your project to various stakeholders within the business and receive structured performance feedback from your Project Leader.

Projects are based in our Adelaide, Brisbane, Perth locations, some projects require students to visit our site locations during placement. In most cases, students are generally employed into projects in their home locations. In the instance that projects are allocated in an alternate location to the applicant's home location, Santos will provide appropriate support to those students for the duration of the program in the project location.

Our Graduate Program includes:

Induction Program which helps first-year graduates find their feet at Santos as they build networks with colleagues throughout the company.

Performance goals are set for each rotation, meaning graduates are clear about their performance outcomes and what they need to focus on. The goals are supported by ongoing feedback conversations with a leader.

Individual development plans are set with each graduate to support technical and professional development, as well as identifying areas of strength and opportunities to build skills, knowledge and competence.
